# Vote of Confidence for Isle of Man International Business School



Following its review by an independent panel from Liverpool John Moores University, The IBS is delighted to report that it has been granted a 5 year contract renewal for its delivery of the university's degree programmes. The IBS currently offers undergraduate and postgraduate degree courses accredited by LJMU to students from the Isle of Man, UK and worldwide on a full-time and part-time basis. This partnership has brought many benefits to the Island since the school opened as it allows for local 'face to face' delivery of an

internationally recognised portfolio of degree programmes.

The review panel undertook an intensive audit of the IBS facilities, teaching standards and delivery methods on all of the academic programmes offered as well as consulting with a wide range of students to gain their feedback. The response from the students and the results of the audit were overwhelmingly positive and have resulted in this five year extension – the best that the school could have possibly achieved.

IBS Director, Professor Roger Carey is extremely proud of this accomplishment:

*“As an institution we have come a very long way in a relatively short period of time. This is a significant moment in the future development of the school and gives recognition to our exceedingly high standards of teaching and facilities as well as the hard work and dedication of all the staff. The next five years will see continued growth, both in the number of students that attend the school and in the range of courses that we offer”.*

With the new contract safely secured, The IBS can look forward to this future expansion. The current student numbers are already speaking for themselves: 2005 has seen more Manx students studying for an undergraduate degree at the International Business School than at any other higher education institution in the world.
