Prestigious Economist to give lecture on tax reform

The Isle of Man International Business School will be hosting a lecture at the Manx Museum on Thursday 12th October at 6.15pm.

The lecture will be given by Professor David R. Myddelton, Chairman of the Institute of Economic Affairs in London, and President of the Economics and Business Education Association. Professor Myddelton will set out and discuss proposals for tax reform in the United Kingdom and more widely.

Professor Myddelton was formerly Professor of Finance and Accounting at the Cranfield School of Management from 1972 until his retirement in September 2005. He was also Chairman of the Cambridge Business Studies Project Trust for more than ten years and has written textbooks in financial accounting, management accounting, financial management and economics; as well as more controversial books on the British Tax system; 'The Power to Destroy' and 'Unshackling Accountants'.
