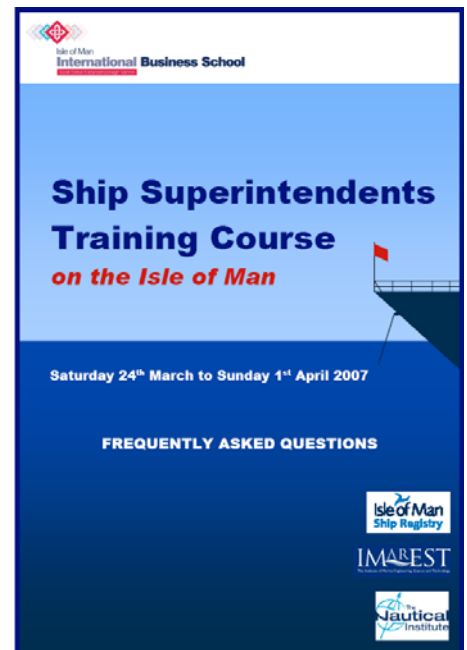
Third Ship Superintendents Training Course to take place on Isle of Man

A unique 9-day intensive training programme for Ship Superintendents will take place on the Isle of Man for the third time during March 2007. The programme is a joint initiative between the Isle of Man Ship Registry and the Isle of Man International Business School and is delivered by a wide range of industry experts.

The course is approved by both IMAREST and the Nautical Institute and has so far attracted delegates from around the world.

The quality assured course is primarily designed for recently appointed ship superintendents or aspiring entrants into the world of ship management or ship ownership – whether working for a ship owner or ship management company; or whether applying from a Deck, Engineering or Naval Architecture background. More experienced superintendents can also be accommodated. There are no prerequisite qualifications for applying to the course and there is no specific bias towards “wet” or “dry” vessels.
